## Minutes Regular Council Meeting Wednesday April 2, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Clawson called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
Council Members present were Audra Thornton, Alan Thornton, and Butch McFall.
Others present were Clerk Ashley Hopkin. Attorney was available by phone if needed (but not present).
Guests present were Debbie Good, Ryan Welling, Ben Jordan, Keith Clarey and Jeff Kaiser.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Forsgren and Associates gave the council a second report on the status of the water master plan, and some of the things they had discovered so far. The recommendations and all of the findings will be included in their final report, along with some estimated costs to correct some of the findings, for the town to consider in the future.

Approval of the minutes for March 19, 2025, they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Butch McFall, and seconded by Audra Thornton, to approve the agenda of April 2, 2025. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report: After having issues with Lulu's website, the Bairoil books were ordered and shipping soon.

Mayor Clawson called some contractors off a list from R.P. Lumber, three of the four called back, and scheduled dates and times to come out and give the town quotes for the repairs at 107 Bluebell.

Old Business: A motion was made by Alan Thornton, and seconded by Audra Thornton, to have a town sale at the riding arena for the remaining school items. This way residents can come and see everything in person. A notice will be sent out to all residents along with it being posted for the surrounding area. Motion passed.

New Business: A motion was made by Audra Thornton, and seconded by Alan Thornton, to get rid of the Sierra wireless and upgrade the internet with Union Wireless at the Town Hall and the Healthcare Clinic. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Butch McFall, and seconded by Alan Thornton, to approve of the mayor's proclamation for April's child abuse prevention month. Motion passed.

Butch McFall made a motion and was seconded by Alan Thornton, to appoint Audra Thornton as chief election judge and Adene Wuertley, Michelle Chavez as judges with Maribel Macey as a backup election judge. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Audra Thornton, and seconded by Alan Thornton, to have a weekly gym membership fee of \$10.00. There have been enough people asking if there is a weekly rate if they are here working for a week or two or on call. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Alan Thornton, and seconded by Butch McFall, to go into executive session at 8:33 p.m. to discuss personnel matters under Wyoming Statutes §16-4-405 (a)(iii). Motion passed. The council came back into regular session at 9:11 p.m. Mayor Clawson asked the council if anyone had any objections to what was discussed in the executive session, no one objected.

A motion was made by Alan Thornton, and seconded by Audra Thornton, to pay check#17086 through check#17097, including all debit card charges and EFT's. Excluding check#17083, 17084, and 17085. Motion passed and Lowell Clawson abstained due to pecuniary interest because there was check#17090 in there for him.

Alan Thornton made a motion and was seconded by Audra Thornton, to pay check#17083 to Butch McFall. Motion passed and Butch McFall abstained due to pecuniary interest. A motion was made by Audra Thornton, and seconded by Butch McFall, to pay check#17084 to Alan Thornton. Motion passed and Alan Thornton abstained due to pecuniary interest. A motion was made by Butch McFall, and seconded by Alan Thornton, to pay check#17085 to Audra Thornton. Motion passed and Audra Thornton abstained due to pecuniary interest, for a total amount in bills \$23,430.81.

With no further business this council meeting was adjourned at 9:11 p.m.
