## Minutes Regular Council Meeting Wednesday November 5, 2025 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Clawson called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
Council Members present were Michelle Chavez, Audra Thornton, Alan Thornton, and Butch McFall.
Others present were Clerk Ashley Hopkin. Attorney was available by phone if needed (but not present).
Guests present were Brandon, Gina and Liam Penry.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for October 15, 2025, they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.
